POSITION: AQUAFITNESS INSTRUCTOR FOR CLEMENS COMMUNITY POOL (CCP)

DESCRIPTION:

CCP supports multiple aquafitness programs for individuals ranging from adolescents to senior citizens who are looking to become more active, lose weight and increase their health. Aquafitness instructors are responsible to planning, teaching and developing the program. Responsible to Lesson Supervisor and Aquatic Director.
